# **5 YEAR REFLECTION FROM THE CEO**

When we started the charity, God taught me some foundational truths around the character of Nehemiah - what he stood for, how he gathered, how he equipped and how he resourced to enable the city gates and the walls to be rebuilt. Very early on I felt God say to me that we can't personally do everything and be everywhere but we can equip and resource many. This became the driving force for our intention to practice and encourage unity across churches and cities. We want to thank God for all the relationships that have been established and have grown over this first 5 years.

We create resources that are built on three foundational truths that are central to how we cheer young people on. These are that we are formed by God, accepted by Jesus and appointed by the Holy Spirit to become influential for God in all arenas of life. I have personally been reminded of this truth throughout the past 5 years. This truth has enabled us to better resource young people and to release them in confidence with them knowing "whose they are" and "who they are in Christ".

We have always sought to observe trends and changes in how young people engage in faith and to be a charity that evolves and adapts to engage effectively with current youth culture. This has led us to recognise that digital innovation is a current means to articulate and open up experiential learning around faith, mission and evangelism. The young people and youth leaders we visit and listen to shape how the charity develops.

The past five years have been amazing and I have been so blessed by the way God has worked through Missional Generation. It has been an incredible learning curve as well as a faith-building time that has deepened my awareness of my relationship with Jesus. I want to thank all those who have supported me and Missional generation by journeying with us over the last five years. You are all hugely appreciated and valued.

# **HOW WE EQUIP**

We have a desire to equip all those supporting young people in Christian roles to make an impact. We equip in many ways one of which is our Live and Share programme (8 weeks of missional, discipleship youth sessions). Live and Share has recently been redeveloped so that it continues to be a fresh, interactive and engaging resource, It helps train and equip Christian young people to become more aware of their own context and local needs, which leads them to be more relevant in mission and evangelism as they develop creative ways to help people.

Missional Generation also provides coaching, session delivery, training and mentoring. This is delivered in a range of settings including at weekly school groups and evening youth groups, residentials, one to one mentoring, youth leader retreats and events.

# **HOW WE GATHER - UNITED CITY MISSIONS**

Three times a year we gather young people to give them opportunities to see the impact their Christian faith can have on their local communities. A team of youth leaders from across Leeds and Bradford run Mission United Faith in Life. We have seen young people proactively share the good news of Jesus in local communities by engaging in social action, working with the elderly, befriending people in need and working alongside a variety of churches that we partner with to meet their local mission objectives.

We equip all who attend to share Jesus in their everyday lives. Here are some reflections from those who have taken part since 2013:

## **OUR RESOURCES**

Over the past five years, we have partnered with a number of different people to create a range of resources designed to equip young people to live influential lives for God and to positively impact the faith of many. Here are a selection of the resources that have been produced and used with youth groups both locally and further afield:





#### **INVISIBLE LIVES:**

Invisible Lives helps young people learn about the injustice taking place in the world. It contains stories from real people's lives as well as teaching from scripture about what we can do to make a difference in the world.

#### THE KING IS COMING:

This devotional Bible study is designed to help you access scripture every day in the lead-up to Christmas. It touches on themes about Christmas, the person of Jesus and the greatest gift we have received.





## JOHN - THE ONE JESUS LOVED DEARLY:

John had a personal relationship with Jesus; he knew who Jesus was because he spent time with Him. This devotion helps reconnect a generation with the understanding of who they are through Christ Jesus.

## **JOURNEY WITH GOD:**

This booklet contains 10 short devotional guides to encourage you on your journey, strengthen your relationship with Father God and steer you away from the traps that the enemy has set.

In addition to our weekly regular visiting school groups and evening youth groups, we have been asked to speak across 52 additional Page 6




## **TIME TRAVEL:**

## THE EASTER JOURNEY

Last year Isaac Bentley, a young person from Leeds, worked with us to create 10 digital artistic interpretations of the Easter story. Alongside these amazing, artistic impressions of the last days of Jesus' life, his death and resurrection; we put together 10 devotions to help people of all ages spend time reflecting on Easter, looking at the Bible and considering Jesus' sacrifice afresh. These resources have been used in schools as part of their collective worship, in youth groups and also as a personal devotion tool.

# 12 REVELATIONS OF CHRISTMAS



We have created an exciting new Augmented Reality, digital Christmas resource. This resource has been designed to be used with children and young people in a range of settings including churches, schools, in detached work and as a personal devotion in the run up to Christmas.

It is called the 12 Revelations of Christmas. Each revelation has an Augmented Reality experience showing a key part of the Christmas story. We have then created a devotion and reflection to use alongside it which encourages young people to look at how they can proactively put the revelation in to action in their daily life.

## **DIGI-INNOVATORS**












A key way in which we develop resources is by proactively encouraging the skills of the young people we work with. For example, we recently mentored a young person called Vlad who, from his own enthusiasm and talent, worked with us to create an Augmented Reality David and Goliath game that has been used in many youth groups across Leeds and Bradford. The game has helped young people explore how they too can put their trust in God to defeat the Goliaths in their life and in the world around them. This resource was nominated for a national award at the Premier Christian Digital Awards in November. Meanwhile, we have seen Vlad grow in confidence and in the realisation that God can use his digital innovation skills to help bring transformation in the lives of other young people.

We believe there is so much more we can do with a digital generation and will do all we can to support young people like Vlad across the churches we support.

## **HOW WE PRAY**

Prayer is at the centre of all we do. We see the change that prayer brings to young people, youth leaders, churches, the cities we work in, communities and to the work of Missional Generation. It is a vital underpinning of all our work as we seek God day-to-day for the work of the Charity.

We gather Christian youth practitioners to pray and we promote unity in youth ministry across church denominations, charities and locations. This includes, (but is not limited to), coordinating regular prayer breakfasts that are led by youth leaders, youth leader retreats and other training and information gatherings.

# THE FOUNTAIN

The work of Missional Generation would not have been possible without people who cheered, prayed and financially walked with Ben. This source of life and strength helped shape Ben into who he is today. We have that same passion to cheer on, pray for and financially assist young people to live out the callings God has placed on their lives and this is the heart behind the vision of The Fountain.



The idea of "The Fountain" is to help fuel, support and facilitate young peoples' ideas and, in doing so, enable them to step out in faith and grow in their calling alongside people who will encourage and guide them. We know that God has given vision and ideas to young people that will see an awakening of the Kingdom of God develop within all arenas of life. Our vision is to help young people become influential for God and we want to invest in to young peoples' ideas so that they might be catalysts in the Kingdom advancing.

The Fountain is a source where ideas grow and take shape. It is a space we are creating for God to use a generation to influence communities and to see the Kingdom of God advance with Jesus shared confidently and creatively with the world.

The Fountain is made up of a panel of Christians from a variety of fields and is a one-stop place for young people to explore an initiative to advance the Kingdom of God. The panel seeks to enable local young people to grow in confidence and awareness of their own calling and gifting. The Fountain panel mentor, listen, equip, support and offer a small amount of funding to resource ideas and to help young people live out their calling and be influential for Jesus.

We will call upon our network of relationships to give young people the opportunity to step out in faith with a God-given idea allowing them to be proactive in their faith in innovative ways. Our prayer is that The Fountain will free them from limitations of resources and give them a safe place to activate their ideas.

How to get connected into the fountain:

Church leaders, youth leaders, mentors and parents can contact Missional Generation for an initial conversation and we will then prayerfully consider whether The Fountain can benefit the young person. After the initial conversation the young person will be asked to complete a short application and this will then be taken to the panel for discussion before inviting the young person to discuss their idea or dream further.
